Hurstle Canada, 83, Brownstown, died at 7:10 p.m. Wednesday, March 10, at Heritage House in Seymour. He had been ill for three years.

He was a Marine Corps veteran of World War II. He was a member of the Tampico Baptist Church and retired from Jackson County REMC after 33 years as a lineman.

He was born Jan. 24, 1916 in

Wayne County, Ky. to the late James E. and Neitha Carrender Canada. He moved to Jackson County in 1946. He married the former Bessie Kidd on Nov. 26, 1936 in Wayne County, Ky., and she survives.
