CARTER RITES ARE SET FOR FRIDAY AFTERNOON

Services to be Conducted from
Brownstown Christian Church
at 2 O'clock.

Funeral services for Mrs. Mary Carter, age fifty-six, wife of D. F. Carter of Brownstown, who died Wednesday morning in the Methodist Hospital at Indianapolis, will be conducted at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Brownstown Christian Church with the Rev. E. E. Pedicord, pastor, in charge. Burial in Brownstown cemetery.

Mrs. Carter had been ill about three years but had only been in the hospital since Friday. It was believed that she was improving when death came suddenly, of heart disease.

Mr. Carter was in Columbus Wednesday, employed as a carpenter in remodeling the home of his sister, Mrs. Fred Robbins, there when he received the news of his wife's death, which came as a severe shock.

She was an active member of Brownstown Christian Church and is well known throughout Jackson and Bartholomew counties. She spent practically all her life in Brownstown.

Besides the husband, she is survived by six children, Cecil, Harley, Hovin and Flora Belle, at home; Myrtle, of Indianapolis, and Mrs. Ruby Fisher, of Salem.
