DEATH RECORD.

CARTER—Mrs. George Carter, whose serious sickness has been mentioned in these columns at different times, died Thursday night, August 31, 1905, aged 61 years, 4 months and 23 days. She had been sick since last March with rheumatism, neuralgia and complication of diseases and her sufferings at times were intense. Her maiden name was Susan E. Cunningham and she was born in Washington county April 8, 1844, where she resided until about seven years ago, when the family moved to Brownstown. She was united in marriage July 16, 1871, to George Carter. To their union were born four children, one of whom died in infancy. One son, Darl. and two daughters, Mrs. Fred Robbins and Miss Gracie, together with their father survive her. She was a member of the Christian church from childhood. The funeral services were conducted at the Christian church at this place Saturday morning at 11 o'clock, Rev. Jos. Lester, of Lesterville, officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.
