Mrs. Amy Cartwright Dies At Nursing Home — Rites Held Sunday

Mrs. Amy Leota Cartwright, widow of Benjamin F. Cartwright, died at 10:45 o'clock last Thursday night at the Westside Nursing Home, in Seymour, where she had been a patient since last February.

She had been in failing health for four years.

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Brownstown Methodist Church in charge of the Rev. E. A. Dawson, retired Methodist pastor, and former local Methodist minister, and the Rev. William Bateman, pastor of the Brownstown Baptist Church.

Burial was in Fairview Cemetery here.

A native and life-long resident of this area, Mrs. Cartwright was born on April 19, 1899, a daughter of the late William H. and Lillian Ruth England Nichols. In February of 1940, she was married to Benjamin F. Cartwright, who died on April 23, 1959.

Mrs. Cartwright was an honorary member of the Auxiliary to Jackson County Barracks, Veterans of World War I.

A daughter, Martha Ruth, survives, as do a brother, Lyman Nichols, who lives on U. S. 50, east of Brownstown, and a sister Mrs. Walter Zimmerman of Seymour.

Mrs. Cartwright was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church.
