Harrison Cartwright Dies of His Injuries

Just one week after the accident, Harrison Cartwright, who fell from the third to the second floor of the new Odd Fellows' building, died of his injuries last Friday afternoon about 1:30 o'clock. The news of his death was quite a shock to our citizens as but few persons realized that his injuries were so serious. The morning of his death he seemed much better and his father went out on his rural mail route as usual. About one o'clock Friday afternoon Harrison was laughing and joking with several around his bedside and seemed in good spirits. Suddenly he was seized with excruciating pains in his head and grew rapidly worse physicians were sent for at once but he died a few minutes after their arrival.

The funeral was held at the M. E. church Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock and were largely attended. The services were conducted by the regular pastor, Rev. T W Northcott, assisted by Rev. A. J. Umberger, of the Baptist church and Rev. J. H. Weaver, of the Presbyterian church, after which the remains were laid to rest in Fairview cemetery. There were many beautiful floral offerings.
