

## Funeral Rites Conducted For Leonard Cartwright

Funeral services for Leonard Cartwright, 60, of Fort Ritner, a former resident of Brownstown and a veteran of World War I, were conducted this afternoon from the Hague Funeral Home, at Medora, followed by burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown. Mr. Cartwright died suddenly Friday night at his home in Ft. Ritner, with death attributed to a heart attack. He had been in failing health for the past three years.

A native of Washington county, where he was born October 25, 1890, the son of the late Jordan and Sarah E. Cartwright, Mr. Cartwright was married at Petersburg, Va., on November 5, 1919, to Sadie Ann Beasley, who survives.

He enlisted in World War I on May 9, 1914, and served until April 9, 1919. He re-enlisted April 11, 1919, serving until July 9, 1921.

Survivors in addition to the widow include one brother, Otis Fleenor, of Milan, and four sisters, Mrs. Amanda Jefferson, Mrs. Zella Shelton and Mrs. Gladys Elkins, all of Brownstown, and Mrs. Alma Foster, of Crothersville.
