Cartwright—The remains of Mrs. Susanna Cartwright, whose death occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Alma Fields, at Ottawa, Ill., Thursday night, April 7, arrived here Saturday morning and were taken to her home on Walnut street.

The death of Mrs. Cartwright came as a shock as it was not known that she was sick. She had been spending the winter in Oklahoma with her sons, Jonas and Benjamin. She started home about two weeks ago and en-route stopped off at Ottawa to visit her daughter and was taken sick with pneumonia, which was the cause of her death.

Deceased was born in Washington county, Indiana, December 14, 1848, making her age at the time of her death 72 years, 3 months and 23 days. She was united in marriage to William Cartwright in 1866 and to their union were born seven boys and three girls, of whom four boys, Sheridan, of California; Benjamin and Jonas, of Oklahoma, and Alva, of Ohio, and two daughters, Mrs. Nina Weathers, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Fields, of Illinois, are left to mourn their loss. She also leaves four brothers, Dr. S. W. Shields, of Brownstown; E. W. Shields, of Lebanon, Kansas; Milton Shields, of Enid, Oklahoma; Sherman Shields, of Tescott, Kansas, and her stepmother, Mrs. Sarah Luck, of Medora.

Early in life she united with the Methodist church and was an active member until death. She was a kind, obliging neighbor and a devoted wife and mother.

The funeral services, which were largely attended, were held at the Methodist church Sunday afternoon at two o'clock Rev. R. I. Black officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
