## Mrs. W. Ireland Dies At B'town

Mrs. Irene C. Ireland, 55, wife of William W. Ireland, of Brownstown, and a well known resident of that community, died at 7:55 p. m. Sunday at the residence. She had been in failing health for the past 10 months and had been seriously ill for several weeks.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Tuesday from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, Brownstown. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Ireland was born Feb. 9, 1902, in Johnson county, Ill., the daughter of the late Joe and Betty Henderson Chism. She was married Oct. 4, 1930, in Chicago, to William W. Ireland, who survives. She had been a resident of Brownstown since her marriage and was an active member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church. She also was a member of three social organizations, the We're Here Club, a sewing club and Home Demonstration Club, Unit No. 1. During her residence of more than a quarter of a century in Brownstown, she made the acquaintance of a wide circle of friends who mourn her death.

Mrs. Ireland had been previously married, on Oct. 10, 1910, to Willa Vance, who died in Jan., 1929 and they were the parents of four children, who survive. They are Alex Vance Ireland, of Spain; Mrs. Lowell L. Haines, of Los Altos, Calif.; Mrs. Robert G. Luthy, of Palo Alto, Calif.; and Master Sergeant James F. Ireland, of Lincoln, Nebr.

In addition to the husband and step-children, she also is survived by two brothers: Roscoe Chism, of Piedmont, Mo. and Ralph Chism, of Sherrard, Ill.; a sister, Mrs. P. E. Wilgus, of Chicago, and 11 grandchildren.
