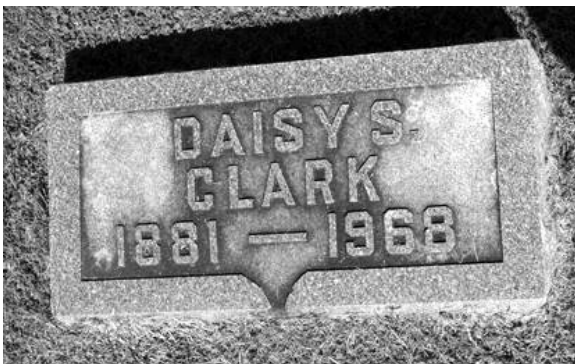

Mrs. Noble C. Clark Dies; Funeral Rites Sunday Afternoon

Funeral rites were held Sunday afternoon from the Zabel Funeral Home for Mrs. Noble C. Clark, life-long resident of this community, and mother of Dr. Roy P. Clark.

In failing health for several years, and seriously ill the past several months, Mrs. Clark died at 10:30 o'clock Thursday night.

A native of Grassy Fork township, Mrs. Clark, the former Miss Daisy Pfenning, was born on July 8, 1881, a daughter of the late John and Amanda Brough Pfenning. She and Mr. Clark were married in Brownstown in 1905. Mr. Clark died in 1930.

Mrs. Clark was a life-long and devout member of Brownstown Presbyterian Church and a member of Brownstown Chapter, Order of Eastern Star.

Surviving in addition to Dr. Clark, are two grandchildren, Dr. R. Joseph Clark, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Charles William Cordes, Sunset Parkway, Seymour, and five great-grandchildren.

A twin sister, Mrs. Alva Hancock, is deceased and a brother died in infancy.

The Rev. Robert Reid, pastor of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church, officiated at the funeral rites. Interment was in Fairview Cemetery.
