PROMINENT BROWNSTOWN MAN SUCCUMBS TO PARALYSIS

**David Clark Expires This Morning
Following Long Illness—Fun-
eral Thursday.**

David Clark, a prominent Brownstown resident and former sheriff at Jackson county, died at his home in Brownstown this morning at 8:30 following an illness of more than four years. The deceased suffered a stroke of paralysis about four years ago from which he partially recovered, but suffered another Sunday morning resulting in death. The deceased was sixty-nine years old.

Mr. Clark was engaged in the grocery business in Brownstown for a number of years. He was a member of the Brownstown K. of P. lodge. Besides a widow the deceased is survived by two daughters, Mrs. James A. Wayman, of Brownstown, and Mrs. Holmes Thompon, of Cortland, four sons, Noble and Worth Clark, of Brownstown and Charles and Hugh Clark, of Iowa.

The funeral service will be held Thursday under the auspices of the K. of P. lodge. Burial in Fairview cemetery at Brownstown.
