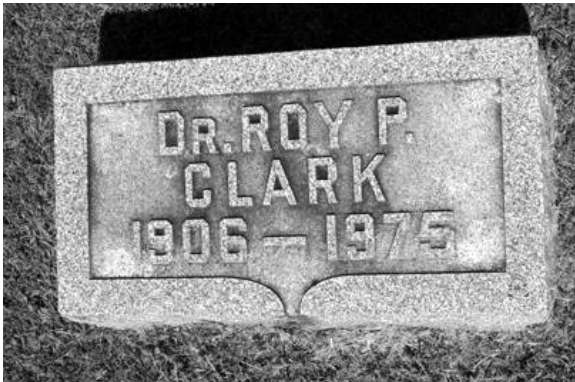

## *Dr. Roy Clark*

Dr. Roy P. Clark, 69, of the Lake and Forest Club, a Brownstown dentist for 45 years, died unexpectedly at 3:50 p.m. Monday, Aug. 18, at the Jackson County Hospital.

Dr. Clark was born June 30, 1906 in Brownstown to the late Noble and Daisy Peenning Clark. On Sept. 22, 1928, in Seymour, he married Mary Lucille Davis, who preceded him in death on Nov. 4, 1968. On June 14, 1969, in Louisville, Ky., he married Lorene Bolly, who survives. She was a former resident of Charlestown.

A 1924 graduate of Brownstown High School, Dr. Clark graduated in 1929 from the Indiana University School of Dentistry. He started his practice in Brownstown in 1929 and retired in 1974.

He was a member of the Jackson and Jennings County Dental Society and was a life member of the American Dental Association, the Indiana Dental Association and the South Central Dental Society.

He was also a member of the Seymour Elks Club, Washington Lodge No. 13, Free and Accepted Masons and a former member of the Brownstown Lions Club and the Brownstown Town Board.

Dr. Clark was a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church and served as an elder and a member of the building committee.

In addition to the widow, survivors include one son, Dr. Joseph Clark, of Lake and Forest Club; one daughter, Mrs. Charles (Mary Lou) Cordes, of 901 South Drive, Sunset Parkway; and seven grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 21, from the Zabel Funeral Home in Brownstown with the Rev. Robert Reid, pastor of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church, officiating. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery.
