Mrs. Mary Clark, 74, Dies—Rites In B'town

Mrs. Mary Clark, 74, of Lake Worth, Fla., a native and long-time resident of Jackson County, died about 10:45 p. m. Sunday in Palm Beach Hospital, Fla., after being ill for one year.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p. m. Friday from the Winklepleck Funeral Home, Brownstown, with the Rev. Ernest Jones, pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
