## Esther Cochram

Esther E. Cochram, 87, of 759 McClure Road, Columbus, died at 9 p.m. Tuesday at Columbus Convalescent Center after an illness of five months.

She was retired from Camp Atterbury where she worked as a nurse's aide and a clerk. She also worked for several years at the Columbus Home for the Aged. She was a member of the Columbus Jehovah's Witnesses.
