Death Summons **Mrs. Cockerham**

Mrs. Cora Beck Cockerham, age sixty-one, a life long resident of the Brownstown vicinity, died at eight o'clock this morning at Schneck Memorial Hospital where she was admitted in a serious condition a week ago. She had been ill for some time.

Mrs. Cockerham, wife of John Cockerham, was born near Brownstown, the daughter of Randolph and Lucinda Waltz Beck. She was married on April 24, 1892, at Rateliff Grove to John Cockerham, who survives. They were the parents of three children, two of whom survive.

Mrs. Cockerham was a member of the Brownstown Baptist Church and of the Auxiliary of Camp Jackson Post No. 112, American Legion, of Brownstown. She had a host of friends in Brownstown who mourn her death.

Besides the husband, she is survived by a son, Ralph Cockerham, of Indianapolis, and a daughter, Mrs. May Kindred, of Brownstown. Seven grandchildren and three great grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon from the Brownstown Baptist Church with the Rev. J. R. Quick, pastor in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
