Dan Cockerham Dies --Funeral Is Monday

Dan Cockerham, 63, of Seymour R1 farmer, died at 1 a. m. today in Veterans' Hospital, Louisville. He had been ill for the past nine months.

A native and life-long resident of Jackson County, he was the son of the late Phillip and Rebecca Mize Cockerham, and was born January 14, 1897.

Mr. Cockerham was a veteran of World War I and had served overseas. He attended the Brownstown Pentecostal Church.

On December 24, 1915, he married the former Leota Briner at Brownstown. Mrs. Cockerham preceded him in death on November 13, 1954.
