Rites Today For Mrs. Cockerham

Funeral services for Mrs. Hazel Cockerham, 36, of Commiskey R1, were conducted this afternoon from the Voss Chapel with the Rev. Walter Cobley of a Jefferson County Baptist church, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Mrs. Cockerham died Saturday at 5:30 a. m. at Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis after an illness of six months. Cause of death was listed as a brain tumor.

Born July 24, 1929, in Medora she was the daughter of the late Alonzo Greathouse and Mrs. Myrtle Williams Greathouse. She had lived in Jackson County most of her life and had spent the last 10 years in the Commiskey area.

On Jan. 10, 1948, in Medora, she married J. C. Cockerham who survives.
