Burial Rites Held Here For Mrs. Dan Cockerham, Resident Of Medora

Burial rites were held in Fairview Cemetery here Tuesday afternoon for Mrs. Dan Cockerham, of Medora, following funeral rites at the Voss Mortuary in Seymour.

Mrs. Cockerham, native of Tampico, and life-long resident of this county, died early Saturday morning at her home on R1 Medora. She had been ill for a year.

The former Leota Briner, she was born December 8, 1896, a daughter of the late Thomas and Amanda Utterback Briner. On Christmas Eve, 1915, she was married in Brownstown, to Dan Cockerham, who survives. She was a member of the Tampico Baptist Church and was widely known throughout all of Jackson county.

Surviving in addition to the widower are eight children: Thomas P. Cockerham, of Ewing; Mrs. May Engleking,

Mrs. Bessie Flick, Mrs. Edna Grider, Mrs. Mina Owens and J. C. Cockerham, all residents of Seymour; William D. Cockerham, of Medora, and Mrs. Ruth Stewart, R1, Medora.
