## Life-Long Resident Of County Dies at 79

Stanley Cockerham, a life-long resident of Jackson county, died of natural causes at his home near Hobson Hill early Thursday afternoon. He was 79 years old.

Mr. Cockerham had been ill since April of this year and critically ill since Monday.

He was born in Jackson county February 23, 1873, the son of James Cockerham and Nancy Allman Cockerham, both deceased. On February 20, 1898, he married Lucy Beavers at Bedford. Eleven children were born of their marriage. Four are deceased. Mr. Cockerham was a member of the Ratcliff Baptist Church and was widely known in the Brownstown area.

Survivors are his widow, four children, Mrs. Dan McCoy, Freetown R1; Mrs. James McCarty, Brownstown R1; Mrs. Robert Grider, Indianapolis; Mrs. Ivan Bane, Freetown, R1; three sons, Kelsa and Cecil Cockerham, Ewing; and Orville Cockerham, Columbus; and a brother, A. V. Cockerham, of Medora.

Surviving also are 37 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Brownstown Christian Church with the Rev. Meyer, of Columbus, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
