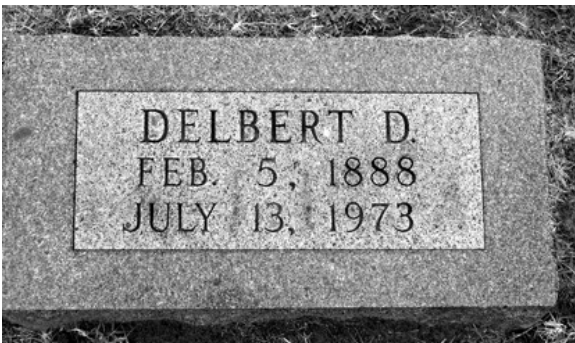

Delbert D. Coldiron, 85, Brownstown Rt. 2, died early Friday morning, July 13, at Jackson County Hospital, after being in failing health for 10 months.
