Mrs. Coldiron Dies At Home

Mrs. Ellen Coldiron, 80, died Thursday afternoon at her Brownstown R2 home. She had been ill for about two years.

A member of the Presbyterian Church at Bear Creek, Ky., she moved to Jackson County and the Tampico vicinity approximately 25 years ago. She was born Feb. 5, 1886, at Bear Creek to the late Andy and Jane Gilbert Baker.

Mrs. Coldiron was married Oct. 6, 1906, at Bear Creek to Delbert D. Coldiron, who survives.
