Mrs. Fannie Mackey Dies At Nursing Home

Funeral rites were held Tuesday afternoon from the Winklepleck Funeral Home for Mrs. Fannie Mackey, 75.

Mrs. Mackey, who had been a resident of Jackson county since 1904, died at 6:00 o'clock Sunday evening in the Westside Nursing Home in Seymour, where she had been a patient for two years and bedfast the past three months.

The mother of ten children, Mrs. Mackey was born on June 7, 1887, in Kentucky, a daughter of the late John and Annabelle Carpenter Kindred.

She was twice married. On February 3, 1904, she was married to Speed Collingsworth, deceased. To this union were born ten children, five of whom are living.

On August 16, 1946, she was married to Jess Mackey, also deceased.

The surviving children are Harry Collingsworth, Mishawaka, Mrs. Eva Barnes, Indianapolis, Mrs. Vivian Weasner and Mrs. Daisy Ashcraft, Seymour, and Mrs. Lillian Rochner, Brownstown.
