Rites Held Today For Aged Medora **Accident Victim**

Abraham Lincoln Collins, Fath-er Of Local Business Man, County Hospital, Evening, From In-uffered Five Hours Dies At Sunday Evening, From In-juries Suffered Five Hours Earlier In Highway Crash.

Funeral rites were held this afternoon from the Spurgeon Funerhere, for 92-year-old al Home. Abraham Lincoln Collins, Medora, R1, father of Charles O. Collins, Brownstown business man, victim of a pre-Independence Day traffic accident.
