Lewis Colvin, 81, Dies At Capital—Rites Set

Lewis Colvin, 81, a resident of Brownstown for more than half a century, died Sunday night at the home of his daughter, Mrs. L. Hudson Doty, 2626 North Harding street, Indianapolis.

Mr. Colvin, who had been retired for a number of years, was born in Ohio but had been a resident of Brownstown for 53 years and enjoyed the acquaintance and esteem of a host of friends who mourn his death. His wife preceded him in death.
