Lloyd Combs, Retired Teacher, Dies, Rites Set

Lloyd Combs, 67, retired Brownstown school teacher, died at 5 a. m. Sunday at Methodist Hospital, Louisville, Ky., after an illness of six months.

He lived at 508 Bloomington Road, Brownstown, and was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, the Knights of Pythias, Lodge No. 60, of Brownstown, and the Brownstown Exchange Club.

Born May 24, 1907, in Jackson County, he was the son of the late Alfred and Anna Mary McMahan Combs.

On Jan. 21, 1928, in Brownstown, he married Maurine Cross who survives.
