

Dr. William M. Conner, 596 Camelot Dr., Seymour, died at 2:45 a.m. Monday, Sept. 22, at St. Vincents hospital, Indianapolis.

A 1944 graduate of the Northern Illinois School of Optometry, Dr. Conner practiced optometry in Jackson County from August, 1945, until September, 1984, after practicing optometry in Indianapolis for a year. He also earned a Bachelor of Science degree in pharmacy from the Butler University School of Pharmacy. He was a registered pharmacist and had licenses to practice optometry in Illinois and Indiana.

In April 1985, he was awarded a lifetime membership in the American Optimetric Association for his years of service. He was also a member of the Brownstown Presbyterian Church, Jackson Lodge 146 F&AM, York Rite Chapter 85, Seymour Elks Lodge 462, and the Fraternal Order of the Eagles Aerie 655.

Dr. Conner, who lived most of his life in Jackson County, was born Sept. 7, 1914, in Brownstown to the late George H. and Ethel Ball Conner.

He married Nina Forgey, and she survives.

Survivors include three children: Richard J. Conner, Pittsburg, Pa.; Dr. Joseph W. Conner, Carmel; and Dr. Cathy Conner, Indianapolis; and two brothers: Dr. Don W. Conner, Sr., Terre Haute; and George H. Conner, Peru.

Funeral services were scheduled at 1:30 p.m. today, Wednesday, Sept. 24, at the Burkholder Funeral Home, Seymour, with the Rev. E. Duane Aelick and Dr. Ralph Smith officiating. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.
