## Miss Cooley Dies, Rites Set Saturday

Miss Cora M. Cooley, 78, 306 East Walnut street, Brownstown, died at 7:35 p. m. Wednesday at the Jackson Park Convalescent Center.

She had been in failing health for two years and a patient at the Center for four weeks.

Most of her life was spent in Indianapolis, where she was a printer and telephone operator before her retirement.

She moved to Brownstown five years ago, and was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, Brownstown Chapter 264, Order of Eastern Star, and Lucullus Temple 142, Pythian Sisters. She helped organize and was a member of the Brownstown Senior Citizens group.
