Charles W. Cordell Dies at Greensburg

Charles W. Cordell, of Greensburg, a native of Freetown, died Monday night at Greensburg, according to word received here.

Mr. Cordell was born November 7, 1882, near Freetown, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Tobias Cordell. On May 9, 1914, he was married to Miss Pearl Boling of Brownstown and they were the parents of four daughters.

He was a former resident of Seymour and was an engineer on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad from 1906-1908. Many friends in this vicinity mourn his death.

He is survived by the widow, four daughters, Mrs. Edna Miselbarr, of Gary, Mrs. Lucille Edwards, Mrs. Jeanette Wheeler and Mrs. Betty Patrick, all of Greensburg; a sister, Mrs. J. A. Reinbold, of Brownstown; a brother, Thomas Cordell, also of Brownstown, and 15 grandchildren.
