

Cordrey—Thomas L. Cordrey, age 44, passed away at the Schneck Memorial hospital, Seymour, Thursday morning at 6 o'clock, where he was taken Tuesday night, July 2, and had undergone an operation for a ruptured appendix. Death was due to complications. He had been in failing health for two years.
