

Injuries sustained in a two-car accident Wednesday afternoon near Waynesville, N. C., in which his three-month-old son was killed instantly and his wife was seriously injured, claimed the life of Rudy Patrick Corrington, 19, of Seymour-Johnson Air Force Base, Goldsboro, N. C., formerly of Brownstown, Thursday night.
