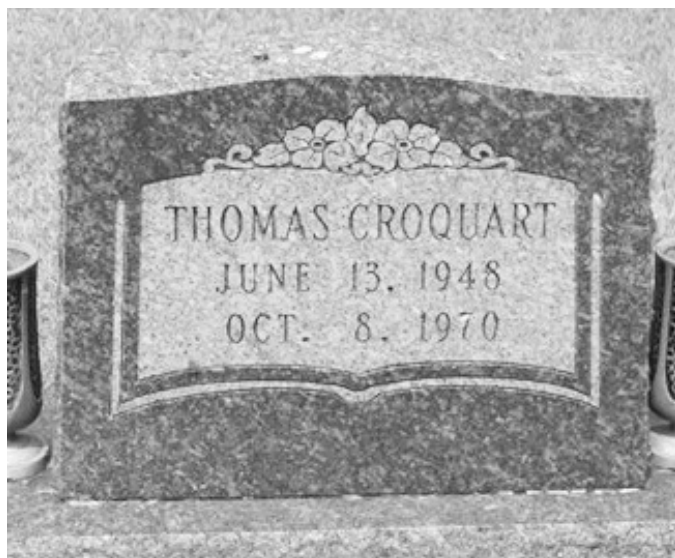

## Rites Set For Victim Of Crash

Funeral services for Harold Thomas Croquart, 22, son of Jackson County Sheriff and Mrs. Harold O. Croquart, of Seymour, will be conducted at 10:30 a. m. Saturday from the Brownstown Christian Church with the Rev. Evan Bolejack, pastor, officiating. Burial in Fairview Cemetery, Brownstown.

Friends may call at the Winklepleck-Weesner Funeral Home, Brownstown, after 5 p. m. today and on Saturday from 9 a. m. until time of service at the church.

Those who wish to give memorials may designate them for the Jackson County Tuberculosis Association.

Mr. Croquart, a student at Indiana State University, Terre Haute, was killed early Thursday morning in a one-car accident in Terre Haute.

He was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church. The Croquart family moved to Jackson County 19 years ago from Cordell, Okla.

Born June 13, 1948, in St. Louis, Mo., he was the son of Harold O. and Helen Hamilton Croquart. In addition to the parents, he is survived by his widow, the former Jacqueline Timko, of Terre Haute, whom he married Sept. 18, 1970; two brothers, Dennis, a student at Ball State University, and Greg, at home; one sister, Martha, a student at Ball State University who currently is student teaching at Seymour High School.

He was studying aerospace technology at Indiana State where he was a member of the Flying Fraternity. He held a private flying license.

Also killed in the crash was Stephen E. Elliott, 22, Bedford R5, a senior at Indiana State.
