

Cross—Howard R. Cross, age 56, a former Jackson county resident, died at his home at Winchester, Ind., Monday, September 7. He had been in ill health for a number of years. The immediate cause of his death was complications.

Funeral services were conducted at Winchester this morning at 10 o'clock. His body was brought to Brownstown and taken direct to Fairview cemetery, where short services were conducted by the Rev. John U. Phelps, pastor of the Christian church, this afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Mr. Cross was born at Houston December 9, 1885, to Richmond and Elizabeth Lockman Cross, both deceased. He formerly taught school in Salt Creek township and later moved to Indianapolis where he owned a drugstore for four years. About twenty years ago he moved to Winchester where he was engaged in the drug business until a few years ago.
