Mrs. Myrtle L. Cross, 78, of Brownstown, died at 8:50 p.m. Thursday, March 19, at the Lutheran Community Home in Seymour.

Mrs. Cross was a retired teacher, having taught in Jackson County schools for 45 years.

A native and lifelong resident of Jackson County, she was born Aug. 18, 1897, to the late William A. and Martha A. Wheeler Lucas. On May 17, 1927, she married H. Clair Cross, who preceded her in death on March 19, 1972.

Mrs. Cross was a member of the Brownstown Christian Church, a member of the American Legion Auxiliary of Camp Jackson Post No. 112, and a member of Brownstown Chapter 264, Order of Eastern Star. She also was a member of Fort Vallonia Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, and the Indiana Retired Teachers Association.
