Crumb—Mrs. Eliza A. Crumb passed away at her home in Brownstown Friday, October 24, at 1 o'clock a. m. of paralysis, aged 79 years, 5 months and 7 days.

Mrs. Crumb suffered a stroke of paralysis March 22, 1921, since which time she had been confined to her bed. Her death came as a shock to her friends. She seemed in her usual health and had eaten a hearty supper. About ten o'clock her niece, Mrs. Dolie Boyatt, who slept in the room with her aunt, noticed that she seemed restless, and went to her bedside and asked if she wanted anything and she told her she felt sick. Dr. Ackerman was sent for and upon his arrival he saw that she had suffered another stroke of paralysis and it was not long until she peacefully passed into that sleep which knoweth no awakening. During her long illness she was patient, kind and cheerful at all times.

Mrs. Crumb was a daughter of Aaron and Eliza Stryker, deceased, and was born in Brownstown, May 8, 1845. In 1876 she was united in marriage to Wm. S. Wheatly, who preceded her in death a few months after their marriage. In 1890 she was married to Isaac Crumb, who died in 1907. She was the last member of a family of twelve children. She was a member of the Methodist church and was a good christian woman. She leaves several nieces and nephews and a host of friends.

Funeral services were conducted at her late home Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, the Rev. T. J. Anthony officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
