Lawrence W. Cunningham, 45, a machinist in Seymour for a number of years, died early Tuesday night. He had been ill for the past 11 years.

Mr. Cunningham was a native of Jackson county, having been born in this county April 6, 1904. He was the son of the late Claude D. and Sarah E. Hall Cunningham. He spent his entire life in this vicinity and was married December 24, 1922, in Seymour to Hazel Covert, who survives.
