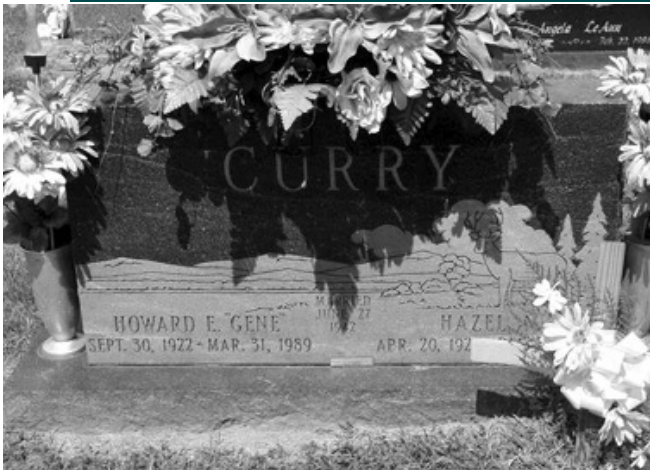

## <sup>4-11-89</sup> Howard E. Curry

Howard Eugene Curry, 66, Medora Rt. 1, died at 9:10 a.m. Friday, March 31, at the Veterans Administration Medical Center, Indianapolis. He had been ill for 4-1/2 years.

Self employed and a farmer, he served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. He was a member of Mt. Zion Methodist Church and a former member of Lodge F&AM 328 at Medora, the Scottish Rite and Murat Shrine, both in Indianapolis.

He was born Sept. 30, 1922 in Jackson County, a son of the late Orva D. and Emma Mae McHargue Curry. He was married June 27, 1942 in Brownstown to the former Hazel N. Fee, and she survives.

Also surviving are three children, James Hubert Curry, Norman; Jack Eugene Curry, Medora Rt. 1, and Linda Sue Isaacs, Brownstown; a brother, Chance Curry of Medora; two sisters, Portia Daugherty, Colorado, and Mrs. Thomas (Ruth) Fox, Norman; 10 grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.
