Alfred Davidson rites Thursday

Alfred Flemon Davidson, 82, formerly of 318 S. Sugar St., Brownstown, died at 6 a.m. Tuesday at Jackson County Schneck Memorial Hospital. He had been in failing health for several years.

Mr. Davidson was a retired farmer.
