Ora B. Davis Dies At Home in Brownstown

Ora B. Davis, 61, well-known life-long resident of Brownstown, died early this morning at his home there after an illness of three months' duration, during which he had been bedfast for the past four weeks.

Born June 21, 1887, in Brownstown, Mr. Davis was the son of Henry and Belle Owens Davis, both of whom preceded him in death. On March 20, 1909, he was married in Brownstown to Beatrice Bland, who survives.

A member of the Brownstown Christian Church, Mr. Davis was employed by the Morgan Packing Company, in Brownstown, and he had a wide circle of friends who join with relatives in mourning his death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon from the Baptist Church, in Brownstown, with the Rev. John U. Phelps in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.

Survivors include the widow, the stepmother, Mrs. Henry Davis, of Brownstown; two daughters, Mrs. Charles Pferrer of Brownstown, and Mrs. Rolland Griffiths, of Columbus; four grandchildren; two half-brothers, Joe Davis, of Washington, D.
