Davis Rites To Be Held Sunday

Funeral services for William Henry Davis, age twenty-one, well known and well liked Brownstown youth, will be conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Brownstown Christian Church with the Rev. William Richmond, pastor, in charge. Burial in Fairview Cemetery.

Mr. Davis, who would have been twenty-two years of age next April 18, died at 10 o'clock Thursday morning at the home in Brownstown following an illness of lobar pneumonia.

Mr. Davis was the son of Ora B. and Beatrice Bland Davis, both of whom survive. He was graduated from the Brownstown High School with the class of 1933 and was popular with his classmates. Since graduating from high school, he had been engaged in the pressing business at Brownstown and had been employed for some time in charge of the cleaning and pressing de-

partment of the Wallace Dry Goods Store at Brownstown. He had attended the Brownstown Christian Church and enjoyed a wide circle of friends.
