Mrs. Dawson, 68, B'town, Dies Monday

Mrs. Ernestine Dawson, 68, of Brownstown died Monday at 9:05 p. m. at the Schneck Memorial Hospital after an illness of six months.

Born Nov. 7, 1898 at Edwardsport, she was the daughter of the late Herbert and Edith Gerald Dale. On July 1, 1915 she married the Rev. Edward Dawson, who survives. He was pastor of the Brownstown Methodist Church from 1936 until 1938, and after his retirement in 1959, he and Mrs. Dawson returned to Brownstown.

Mrs. Dawson was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church and the Women's Society of Christian Service of the church. She also was a member of Home Demonstration Club Unit No. 2 and the District of Spirited Life.

Survivors, in addition to the husband, include three daughters, Mrs. Edmond Wayman and Mrs. James W. Spurgeon of Brownstown and Mrs. Leo Jenkins of St. Petersburg, Fla.; one brother, Herbert Dale of South Bend; two sisters, Mrs. Grace Collins of Indianapolis and Mrs. Lillian Hoekstra of Niles, Mich.; seven grandchildren and one great grandson.
