Mrs. Faye DeGolyer, Formerly Of B'town, Succumbs Suddenly

Mrs. Faye Blevins DeGolyer, of Indianapolis, formerly of Brownstown, a daughter of Mrs. Carrie Blevins and the late Eugene Blevins and a sister of Brownstown Central High School Assistant Principal James T. Blevins, died suddenly at her home in Indianapolis, Sunday.

She was born in September of 1913 and in May of 1953 was married to Oral DeGolyer, who survives.
