

Sherman Dean Dies Suddenly

Sherman Pleny Dean, 78, Norman R1, died suddenly at 12:30 p.m. Thursday en route to a doctor's office. Mr. Dean reportedly became ill at home and a neighbor, Roy Howe, was taking him to a physician. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

Mr. Dean was born March 29, 1890, in Fairmount, the son of the late Arkillis and Sarah Jane Christopher. He moved to Jackson County 36 years ago. He was married to Marian Huffman who survives.
