SON OF BROWNSTOWN SCHOOL OFFICIAL PASSES

**Dale Denny, Age Fourteen, Is
Summoned at 3 O'clock This
Morning.**

Dale Denny, age fourteen, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Denny, of Brownstown, died at the home in Brownstown at 3 o'clock this morning. He had been afflicted about six years ago and had been crippled since that time. During the past month, his condition had failed rapidly until his death.

The lad's father is superintendent of the Brownstown schools and is well known in Seymour. Dale was born April 14, 1919, in Noble county while his father was principal of schools in that vicinity and he since resided with his parents at Freetown and for the past several years had lived in Brownstown.

When his health permitted, Dale was regular in attendance at Sunday School and worship services of the Methodist Church and was dearly loved by all who knew him. Many friends mourn his passing. He was a member of the Brownstown Methodist Church.

Besides the parents, he is survived by three sisters, June, Mary Jane, and Ida Jean, and one brother, Charles Wilburn, all at home.
