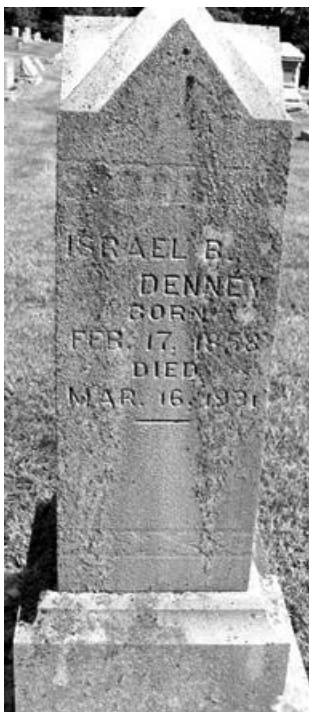

Denny—Israel B. Denny, age 73, a former Brownstown resident, passed away suddenly at his home at San Jose, Calif., March 16. Death was due to heart trouble.

The body arrived here Saturday evening and was taken to the Wallace Funeral home. Funeral services were held at the Methodist church Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock the Rev. L. S. Lovell officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery.

Mr. Denny was the son of Thomas and Clarissa Boling Denny and was born at Ladoga, Indiana, February 17, 1858. When a young boy he moved with his parents to Washington county, near Cayanaugh Ferry, where he spent the greater part of his life. He resided in Brownstown a number of years and was employed in W. R. Bolles' store. After the death of his wife he moved to California. He will be well remembered by many Brownstown citizens.
