Straussie Denny rites Thursday

Straussie L. Denny, 91, Hoosier Christian Village, Brownstown, formerly of Freetown, died at 9 a.m. Tuesday at Hoosier Christian Village. She had been in failing health for three years.

She was a member of Freetown United Methodist Church and of Brownstown Chapter 264, Order of Eastern Star, and was a housewife. She was a lifelong county resident.

Born Jan. 23, 1898, in Jackson County, she was the daughter of James Matt and Dora Engle Fleetwood. On May 4, 1918, in Jackson County, she married J. Frank Denny. He died July 10, 1969.
