Obituary

Mrs. Tessie M. Denny, age 63, died at her home at Kurtz Saturday morning. Death followed an illness of a heart ailment. She had been in ill health several years.

Mrs. Denny was born at Freetown October 25, 1882, the daughter of Samuel A. and Laura Tinch Braden, both deceased. She was married at Brownstown November 16, 1901, to Charles Denny, who survives. She was a member of the Freetown Methodist church and the Eastern Star at Kurtz, and was held in high esteem by a large circle of friends. They had lived in Kurtz since 1908.
