Services Friday for William Noble Dierker

Funeral services for ²⁸⁻¹⁰⁶ William Noble Dierker, 59, former resident of Brownstown who died Tuesday in Batesville, Ark., will be conducted Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Winklepleck Funeral Home with the Rev. Russell Hall officiating. Burial in Fairview cemetery, Brownstown.

Mr. Dierker had been ill several months at the time of his death. He was born in Brownstown June 27, 1889, the son of William and Dilly Barkman Dierker. He married Grace Burrell May 20, 1914 and soon afterward moved to Granite City, Ill., where he lived until recently when he moved to the home of his daughter, Mrs. Margaret Flynn in Batesville. Mrs. Dierker died in 1936.

Surviving besides Mrs. Flynn, at whose home he died, are a son, William E. Dierker, Granite City, Ill.; a sister, Mrs. Mayme Weddle, San Bernadino, Cal.; a grandson, Kenneth Noble Dierker, Granite City, and several nieces and nephews. A second daughter, Miss Mayme Dierker, died in 1945.
