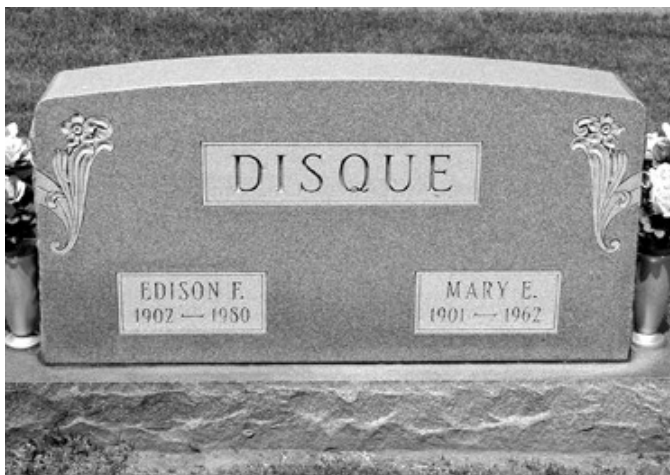

Mrs. Edison Disque Dies At Hospital— Rites Held Saturday
