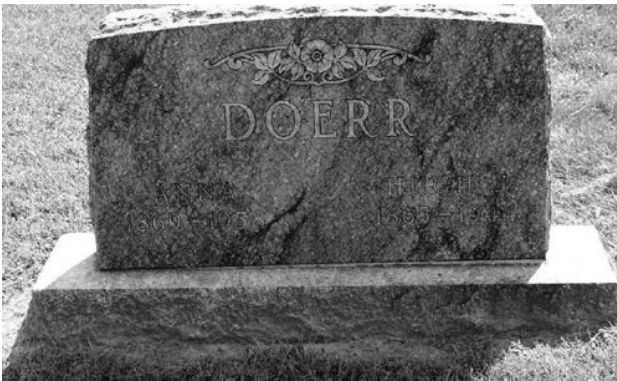

**Former County Man Dies in Oklahoma**

Hugh Doerr, age about seventy-five, a former resident of Jackson county, died Wednesday at his home in Sulphur, Okla., according to word received by relatives in Brownstown.

Mr. Doerr, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Christian Doerr, who lived on the Brownstown-Vallonia road, made his home near Brownstown until about twenty years ago, when he and his wife, the former Miss Rose Young, of Brownstown, moved to Sulphur, Okla. During his residence in this county Mr. Doerr was a farmer, and he and Mrs. Doerr were members of the First Baptist Church in Brownstown. A host of friends among older residents of this county remember him well, and join with relatives in mourning his death.

Funeral arrangements have not yet been completed, but services will be conducted in Brownstown, it has been learned.

Survivors, in addition to the widow, include one daughter, Miss Audrey Doerr, of Sulphur; one brother, Grover Doerr, of Brownstown; and two sisters, Misses Myrtle and Gertrude Doerr, both of Brownstown.
