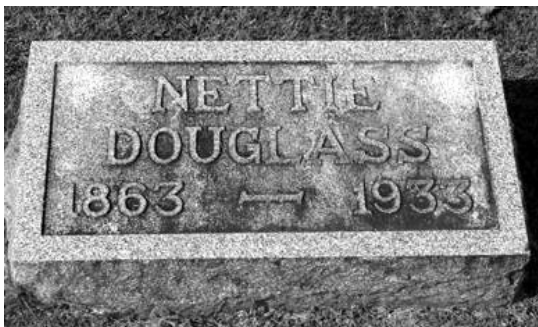

## WEEKLY DEATH RECORD

Douglass — Mrs. Nettie Douglass passed away at the Madison hospital Tuesday morning, July 4, at 7 o'clock, age 70 years.

Nettie McCormick was the eldest of nine children born to Abel and Rebecca Hamilton McCormick, both deceased. She was born on what is known as the McCormick homestead a mile east of Brownstown, May 28, 1863, and spent practically her entire life in Jackson county. She attended the township school and taught several terms of school in Hamilton township.

Mrs. Douglass had been in failing health for several years. She was of a jovial disposition, a devoted mother and a kind, obliging friend and neighbor. She affiliated with the Presbyterian church and was a member of the Ladies Aid Society.

On February 26, 1889, she was united in marriage to Stephen A. Douglass, in Hamilton township. To their union were born three children. Soon after their marriage they moved to Brownstown, where they spent a few years and then moved to Lafayette, later returning to Brownstown.

Surviving are two sons, and one daughter, Frank and George Douglass and Mrs. Kittie McOsker, all of Brownstown; one grandson, Pat McOsker; five sisters: Mrs. Belle Tutton and Miss Berte McCormick, both of Brownstown; Mrs. Arthur Benton, of LaRoma, Dominican Republic; Mrs. Sadie Jull, of Madison, Wisconsin; Mrs. Frankie Ripple, of Fullerton, California, and one brother, Bruce McCormick, of Otis, California. Mr. Douglass died March 12, 1926.

Funeral services will be conducted at the residence Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock in charge of the Rev. Roy Brumbaugh, pastor of the Presbyterian church. Burial in Fairview cemetery.
