## Harold D. 'Boyd' Duncan

Aug. 5, 1920 - Feb. 3, 2012

Harold D. "Boyd" Duncan, 91, a lifelong Tampico resident and resident of Lutheran Community Center in Seymour, passed away at 10:30 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 3, 2012.

Born Aug. 5, 1920, in Tampico, he was the son of Virgil and Eva (Durham) Duncan, who are both deceased.

He was a 1938 Tampico High School graduate.

Boyd enlisted in the U.S. Navy on May 24, 1944. He served in the South Pacific theater of World War II, which included Solomon Islands and New Guinea. He was honorably discharged Jan. 20, 1946.

On Feb. 1, 1941, in Uniontown, he married Juanita (Stout) Duncan, who survives in Tampico. He retired from Cummins Inc. in 1977 and then owned a farm draining service for 17 years.

Boyd was a lifelong member of Tampico Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon and a Sunday school teacher. He was also a member of Brownstown American Legion and was a very active member of Grassy Fork Township Volunteer Fire Department. After he couldn't go on fire runs, he made sure the fire doors were open and everything was ready for the fire department to leave. When he wasn't working, he enjoyed fishing and gardening.

Survivors include his loving wife of 71 years, Juanita (Stout) Duncan of Tampico; four daughters, Connie Jean (Edward) Karnes of Seymour, Donna Sue (William) Hill of Middleburg, Ky., Linda Diane
